If you have not already been out to see this new feature of the Discovery Trail...come out for a visit.



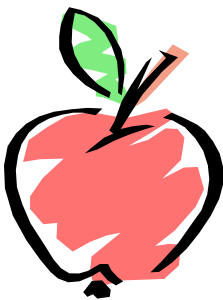
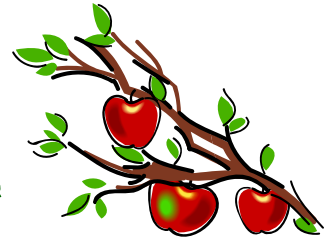

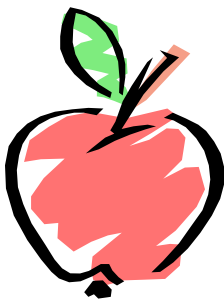
Good-Bye

This was a wonderful bunch of kids that we will never forget and we don't think they will ever forget this week either!



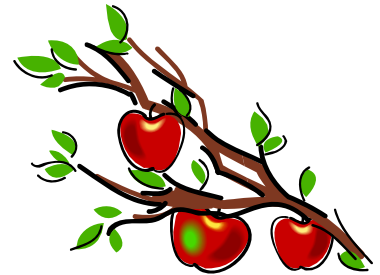

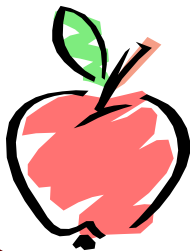
